Outgoing transfers

Northampton College does not have a formal arrangement for the transfer of students wishing to study their programme at another institution.

Should a Northampton College student wish to withdraw from programme and continue at another institution, it is the new institution's responsibility to consider the transfer request, in accordance with their admissions policy and procedure.

Should a Northampton College student complete and attain individual Pearson modules, a certificate may be claimed. It is the new institution's responsibility to accept or decline applicants who have achieved modules and are mid-way through the programme.

Northampton College staff continue to support their Higher Education students on a case by case basis, as well as signpost for further information advice and guidance appropriately.

Incoming transfers

Northampton College consider applicants who are mid-way through their programme at another institution, taking into consideration prior learning and experience in accordance with the College's Recognition of Prior Learning Procedure.

It is within Northampton College's discretion when considering applicants who have missed significant tuition, guided learning and/or attainment gaps at another institution.
